New Business

→ Scholar Athletes and Scholar Athlete Teams

◆ All of our teams are scholar-athlete teams! 75% of the team needs to have an average of 95% or above.

◆ Scholar athlete tees- not a problem in the fall but it becomes an issue moving forward throughout the year. Fall shirts arrive in January, Winter in April, and then Spring becomes difficult. We are going to continue to come up with ideas but are agreeing to move forward with the fall sports t-shirts.

→ Text Message Fundraising

- ◆ Fundraising for sports should always go through us because we are a separate entity. We have used text fundraising for the last two years for football, it seems to work well because of the merger, communication differences, and the parent population. Snapraise came in to meet with the coaches about the text fundraising and they were enthusiastic supporters until Coach Bailey was asked for her SSN, home address, etc... Snapraise should only require a W9 from us but they asked for the other information for a background check.
- ◆ Wrestling has decided to pivot and go with a different text fundraising company, Adrenaline.

→ Nash Weston Onorato Memorial Foundation

◆ We are all in agreement that the booster club's proceeds of two nights of concession will be given to the foundation. Antonia is going to come up with a flyer to create some buzz about the concession. We are going to jazz up the concession stand those nights with walking tacos and mac & cheese as well as provide a change jar for donations. All of this came about from Antonia's suggestion to donate from the Booster Club, thank you, Antonia!
