## Treasurer's Report

The January bank statement was reconciled to the Booster Club ledger. As of January's month-end, the Booster Club checking account had a total balance of \$38,457.85. There are seven outstanding checks totaling \$2,551.94. The Booster Club General Fund had a balance of \$5,248.16, while the Individual Team Accounts had a balance of \$30,657.75.
