Treasurer's Report

The February bank statement was reconciled to the Booster Club ledger. As of February's month-end, the Booster Club checking account had a total balance of \$41,597.93. There are nine outstanding checks totaling \$3,231.76. The Booster Club General Fund had a balance of \$3,579.53, while the Individual Team Accounts had a balance of \$34,786.64. The February Profit and Loss Statements will be sent to all the Varsity Coaches this week.

NOTE: The Booster General Fund is actually at \$11,400. The total reflected above is understated at \$3,579 due to the Softball Florida trip payment coming out and waiting on the rest of the Florida deposits to come in.

- Winter banquets to be held in March for Cheer, Wrestling, Girls & Boys basketball. Incoming for those are overstated until reconciliations are complete.
- Indoor Track held a successful dine to donate fundraiser. Total raised \$400.10% of that to Booster.
- Indoor Track held a successful bundt cake fundraiser. Total net \$590. 10% of that to Booster.
- Indoor Track held a successful text fundraiser totaling \$976. That IS NOT deposited yet. Will finish reconciling in March.
- The boys' basketball team also had a successful text fundraiser totaling \$1,917.20. 10% of that to Booster.
- Football held a successful Superbowl pool with a total donation to that program of \$1,000.

- The Booster Club General Fund had a \$500 donation from Taffy Le & Christopher Ryan.
- All Banks have been returned at this point, other than the indoor concession, as that is still needed.
- BRD was a huge success. Total profit \$7,148.27. Here are the following program credits:
