Treasurer's Report

- The September bank statement was reconciled to the Booster Club ledger. As of September month-end, the Booster Club checking account had a total balance of \$49,085.69. There are twelve outstanding checks totaling \$13,416.40. The Booster Club General Fund had a balance of \$5,112.95 while the Individual Team Accounts had a balance of \$30,556.34. The September Profit and Loss Statements will be sent to all the Varsity Coaches.

NOTES FOR SEPTEMBER STATEMENT

- The Booster club board execs set up a table at Guiseppes during their vendor market, profiting from sales of mums, merch, and donations! The club also had a generous monetary donation from Kimberly Jensen of \$150 and held a successful Dine to Donate fundraiser on the first day of school at Hill Creek, netting \$250!
- The Booster Club Sponsor Banner is still being processed and money is still being collected. This total should be around \$6K to the general fund! The Booster Club Mum fundraiser was completed at the end of September and was very successful, with the sale of 352 mums! However, this money is still being processed and reconciled, and program credits are on hold due to the expenses still being due. This will be completed during October.
- Girls Soccer held a successful car wash fundraiser with a net of \$1,312; 15% of that went to the Booster General Fund, totaling \$196. The program also held a successful 50/50 fundraiser with a net of \$280; 15% of that went to Booster GF, totaling \$42. Lastly, the program had an apparel store with a net of \$51.15; 15% of that went to Booster GF, totaling \$7.
- Football held a successful text fundraiser with a net of \$1,018; 15% of that went to the Booster General Fund, totaling \$152.
- Current Fundraisers running: Boys Soccer is in the midst of a Market 32 Big League Raffle fundraiser.
- Cheer is in the midst of a Krispy Kreme fundraiser.
- The Booster General Fund is in the midst of our
- annual Wreath fundraiser. This will be a GF fundraiser only and not credited to any programs this year, as the GF needs funds due to HUDL and overall expenses this year. All of these are up on the Booster website for purchase!
