Treasurer's Report

→ The August bank statement was reconciled to the Booster Club ledger. As of August month-end, the Booster Club checking account had a total balance of \$39,994.07. There are seven outstanding checks totaling \$5,775.27. The Booster Club General Fund had a balance of \$3,379.49 while the Individual Team Accounts had a balance of \$30,839.31. → NOTES FOR AUGUST STATEMENT

- ◆ Boys Soccer held a successful car wash fundraiser with a net of \$1,107; 15% of that went to the Booster Club.
- ◆ General Fund totaling \$166.00.
- ◆ Booster general fund sponsor banner money is rolling in!
- ◆ Currently, there are no old outstanding checks.

Request to Fundraise/Review of Fundraising Efforts

→ Request to fundraise for girls' basketball – text/call donation. Using the same contact as girls' soccer.

→ Waiting on 10 more checks. The majority are still locked in. There will be at least \$500 more to come.

→ Camera for Hudl

- ◆ It's very expensive, and many of our programs don't have the funds.
- ◆ Hudl cameras are at other schools.
- ◆ Hudl camera for our new stadium field is being discussed with Sanada and our AD, Chad. One iPad for every team would be requested. We will follow up with Chad.

New Business

→ Banner

Booster is setting up a table there and will be selling mums, apparel & wreaths.

→ Fundraising

- ◆ Always encourage fundraising. We won’t say no unless it's something we legally can’t do. All we ask is that the team moms put in the request to fundraise form that can be found on the booster club website. The fundraising request will be discussed with the executive board, and team moms will be notified of the decision via email.
- ◆ Previously, programs had a lot of money, and they continued to have parents paying for things (bowling is \$15 still per person). Money is to be used for the student-athletes.
- ◆ Discussion about “donation” on the website. Those are not considered a request to fundraise. The general fund doesn’t get a percentage of those “donations”, only fundraisers.
- ◆ New Ideas
 - 5K fundraiser for cross-country program
 - Mr. Tamarac – entertainment – fundraiser – talent show competition – interview section – Lindsay Beraldi put this forward.
 - Bigger fundraiser – silent auction – basket raffles
 - Craft fair – vendor fair – garage sale – pumpkin carving for little kids – painting pumpkins
 - Boys and girls play soccer in the spring at the new stadium.
 - Alumni Game

→ Expense Reports

- ◆ This is a new requirement. If we were to get audited, we need to know where these funds went.
- ◆ Team moms and coaches need to work on this together. We need to know what funds are being spent on.
- ◆ Program Spending Plan discussed.

→ Yearbook Picture

- ◆ Take pictures at a home game.
- ◆ Team pictures and senior pictures need to be submitted; team moms are responsible for these pics.

→ My Jersey, Your Impact

- ◆ Players pick any faculty/staff K-12 and give them a pin and their jersey for the day.
- ◆ 33 senior players across all programs.
- ◆ It won't happen on the same day as a senior night.
- ◆ Krista will order the pins.
- ◆ 5 of those 33 seniors go to New Visions. Those 5 student-athletes would like to go the Thursday before. Chad or Courtney will have to take the pictures b/c Antonia has a 1:1 and can't leave him to take the pictures.
