### Athletic Director's Report

- We had a great end to the fall season.
- We can meet to discuss Fall Awards Night – overall, it went well, but there are a few adjustments we should make for next year.

- Several big events are coming up soon, including:

- We are looking into ordering a new shot clock.

### Concession

- We acknowledge that the concession was a little low, but it was purposeful, as there was a lot of waste at the end of the year. It is currently restocked and ready to go.
- Large bags of chips weren't available, so there are now small bags, but they are still the same price.

## Treasurer's Report

- The December bank statement was reconciled to the Booster Club ledger. As of December month-end, the Booster Club checking account had a total balance of \$39,022.06. There are ten outstanding checks totaling \$2,614.25. The Booster Club General Fund had a balance of \$9,305.46 while the Individual Team Accounts had a balance of \$27,102.35.

- Notes for December Statement
  - ◆ Coaches vs Cancer will have totals in Jan or Feb of funds going to GF as well as any individual programs that may have helped with door entries to raise money! GF Holiday Bankroll brought in a net to the general fund of \$7,500!
  - ◆ Girls' Basketball held a text fundraiser and raised \$8,962!!! With 15% of that going to the GF, totaling \$1,344.
  - ◆ Wrestling held a text fundraiser and raised \$2,627.20! With 15% of that going to the GF, totaling \$394.
  - ◆ Cheer held a Breakfast with Santa fundraiser and raised \$1,109! With 15% of that going to the GF, totaling \$166.35.
  - ◆ Track athletes volunteered to help prep for the Turkey Trot, bringing in \$600! This was split between the 3 track programs. \$200 to Cross Country, \$200 to Indoor Track & Field, with 15% of each going to the GF of \$30 for each program.
