- The pipe in the outdoor concession area has been repaired, and the water will be turned on when needed. At this time, we do not anticipate needing it until the Heads of Hope event on May 31, 2026.

Treasurer's Report

The March bank statement was reconciled to the Booster Club ledger. As of March month-end, the Booster Club checking account had a total balance of \$46,899.23. There are fifteen outstanding checks totaling \$4,832.32. The Booster Club General Fund had a balance of \$13,494.25. There is also a balance allocated to Coaches vs Cancer of \$518.55 and Hall of Fame of \$1,741.00 both of which to be

used for those events/donated. The Individual Team Accounts had a balance of \$26,313.11. The March Profit and Loss Statements will be sent to all the Varsity Coaches.
