### Concession

- We had a very successful winter season, thank you to everyone who pitched in and made it happen.
- The executive board is working together to come up with SOPs for concession management in the future.

- Spring concession is on hold while we are waiting for work to be done on the building and for water to be run to the building as well. We will likely be holding off until fall.
- We are looking for ideas to help us unload the excess of chips that we have. Multiple school groups are looking to possibly purchase these from the booster.

## Treasurer's Report

- The February bank statement was reconciled to the Booster Club ledger. As of February month-end, the Booster Club checking account had a total balance of \$52,828.24. There are eleven outstanding checks totaling \$2,399.50. The Booster Club General Fund had a balance of \$11,183.44. There is also a balance allocated to Coaches vs Cancer of \$6,275.19 and Hall of Fame of \$1,741.00, both of which are to be used for those events/donations. The Individual Team Accounts had a balance of \$31,229.11.

## → Notes for February Statement

- ◆ Big Red Day's final net is \$8,474.44 with \$683.25 going to GF for 15% of concession, making the split between the 7 teams \$7,791.19, totaling \$1,113 per team!
- ◆ Coaches vs Cancer money is still being reconciled. Will have totals completed in March for the funds going to GF, as well as any individual programs that may have helped with door entries to raise money.
- ◆ Indoor track held an apparel fundraiser and raised \$330. 15% of that is going to the GF, totaling \$49.50.

- ◆ Indoor track held a dine to donate fundraiser and raised \$200. 15% of that is going to the GF, totaling \$30.
