- The April bank statement was reconciled to the Booster Club ledger. As of April month-end, the Booster Club checking account had a total balance of \$47,493.44. There are six outstanding checks totaling \$1,718.96. The Booster Club General Fund had a balance of \$13,026.98. There is also a balance allocated to Coaches vs Cancer of \$1,068.55, Hall of Fame of \$1,741.00, and RWG Day \$500.00; all of which will be used for those events/donated. The Individual Team Accounts had a balance of \$29,437.95. The April Profit and Loss Statements will be sent to all the Varsity Coaches.

- ◆ Coaches vs Cancer Money has been all reconciled. There is a running balance currently in that P&L. Nets to programs who helped cover the door and run the concession are completed, and as follows:

- General Fund \$1,050
- Boys Basketball \$750
- Girls Basketball \$375
- Softball \$375
- Girls Lacrosse \$200.

- Heads of Hope money is being run through the Booster General Fund to help with the fundraiser for the American Brain Tumor Association. We are taking sponsorships and donations only. All registrations are being run through ABTA.
- Booster Club received a donation of \$500 to Track & Field from Guiseppe's.
- Wrestling Donation of \$159 from Meghan Jewitt/Pittstown United Methodist Church.
- Indoor Track Donation of \$25 from Tana LeBlanc to help offset the banquet.
- Winter Banquets have all been reconciled and completed.
- The Booster Club General Fund held an apparel fundraiser and raised \$60.
- Track & Field held a bundt cake fundraiser and completed it with a net of \$695.50. 15% of that will go to the GF, totaling \$104.32.
- Track & Field held an apparel store fundraiser and raised \$280. 15% of that is going to the GF, totaling \$42.
- Boys' Lacrosse held a calendar fundraiser and raised \$480. 15% of that is going to the GF, totaling \$72.

- Boys Lacrosse held a dine to donate fundraiser and raised \$300. 15% of that is going to the GF, totaling \$45.
- Boys' Lacrosse held a text fundraiser and raised \$3,054. 15% of that is going to the GF, totaling \$458.10.
